### Scour protection work near White Houses

The Environment Agency's contracting partner VBA (VolkerStevin) will shortly be carrying out some work in the White Houses area of Mytholmroyd. Following completion of the Mytholmroyd Flood Alleviation Scheme (FAS), we now need to increase the level of scour/erosion protection currently in place in the area shown in the map below.

The work involves replacing the large crushed rock (Rip Rap) in the river channel behind White Houses with Dycel units (pre-cast concrete). An example of Dycel units is shown in the photograph to the right.



The work is due to commence on 17 April 2023 and will take around four weeks to complete (weather permitting).

Access to the river will be via the flood gate at White Houses for the excavator and for material deliveries. Please could we ask that this area is kept clear of all vehicles between the hours of 0700 and 1800. Traffic management of all movements will be by Stop and Go boards.

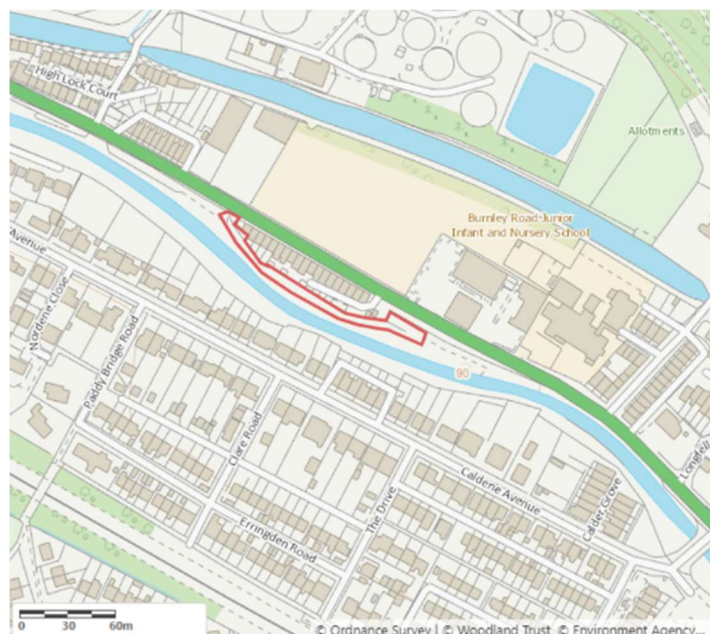
We appreciate your patience whilst we carry out these works and will endeavour to keep any disruption to a minimum.
