## Resurfacing work – Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> November

As part of the continued preparation work for the Hebden Bridge Flood Alleviation Scheme (FAS), our contracting partner BAM Nuttall will be completing the recent trial hole work by carrying out some resurfacing work at a number of locations in the town.

The work will commence on New Road on Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> November at around 6.30am (to avoid peak travel times) with Stop/Go boards in place to maintain the traffic flow. Work will then continue onto Bridge Gate and finish on Crown Street.

We hope to complete the resurfacing work to all areas that day.

We will endeavour to keep any disruption from this work to a minimum and apologise for any inconvenience this work causes.
