

Mytholmroyd Flood Alleviation Scheme

Ground Anchor Works

The Environment Agency's delivery partner VBA (VolkerStevin) will shortly be carrying out scheduled inspection work to flood defences in Mytholmroyd.

Following completion of the Flood Alleviation Scheme (FAS), regular checks are needed to ensure the anchors at St Michael's Church and Calder Grove, which support the flood defence walls, remain in good working condition. To carry out these checks, scaffolding will be installed to access the walls and perform the necessary testing.

Work will be carried out in the areas shown on the map below (red lines). Anyone directly affected by the work will be contacted separately.



Although you may notice scaffolding and workers in the village and river area, please be assured that this is a routine inspection. There will be minimal noise and no disruption to traffic in the area.

The work is set to begin on 16th September 2024 and is expected to take around two weeks to complete, depending on weather conditions.
