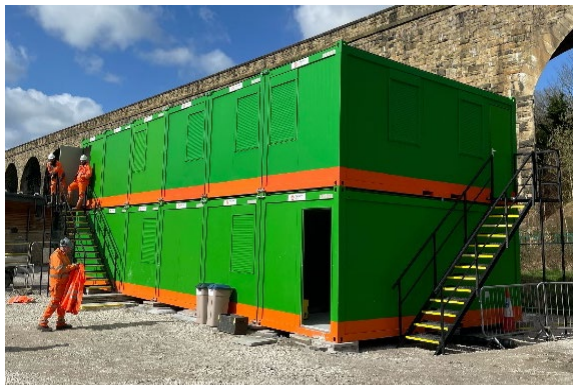
## Information Bulletin No.5 – February 2025

### The Scheme

The flood alleviation scheme in Copley involves improvement to the existing flood embankment that surrounds the village, work at the cricket pitch to speed up the rate of drainage and solutions to manage and reduce surface water flood risk.

### Progress Update

Following completion of the main construction works in Copley village, the BAM team have removed all temporary access routes and wooden fencing from the embankment. The embankment has been built back up and regraded to its original levels, covering the sheet piles that have been installed throughout 2024. The remaining works in the coming weeks will be focused on the section of embankment at the end of St Stephens Street.



Although works will be completed in the next few weeks, the embankment will remain closed to the public until at least Summer 2025. This is to allow for grass seeding to be sown and for it to establish.

During week commencing 3<sup>rd</sup> February, the BAM offices will be demobilised and removed from the Copley Cricket Club grounds. Residents may notice larger vehicles travelling along Copley Lane whilst this takes place.

### Copley FAS – Phase 2

Work to develop a second phase of the scheme is continuing and we hope to submit a planning application for this in the coming months. This is expected to include additional work at Copley Cricket Club and a canal overflow to reduce surface water risk.
