Zone A – River Calder



Work in Zone A

New flood walls will be constructed along both banks of the River Calder, which will include the refurbishment or rebuild of existing river walls. The works will increase the height of walls in some locations and include repointing. De-vegetation will be undertaken on the existing riverside walls and external building walls to allow access to these areas in order to refurbish and re-point the joints.

The most substantial wall rebuilds are required along the left bank adjacent Calder Terrace car park and Hebden Royd Methodist Church, as well as on the right bank adjacent the Grade II listed The Neptune.

There will also be internal strengthening works to non-designated buildings.

The layout of the Co-op car park will change slightly to move parking spaces away from the new flood wall. This means that additional trees can be planted providing a new vegetated frontage along the river in this area. →

Vegetation on the river walls will be removed to enable access for construction, refurbishment and maintenance of the flood defence.
