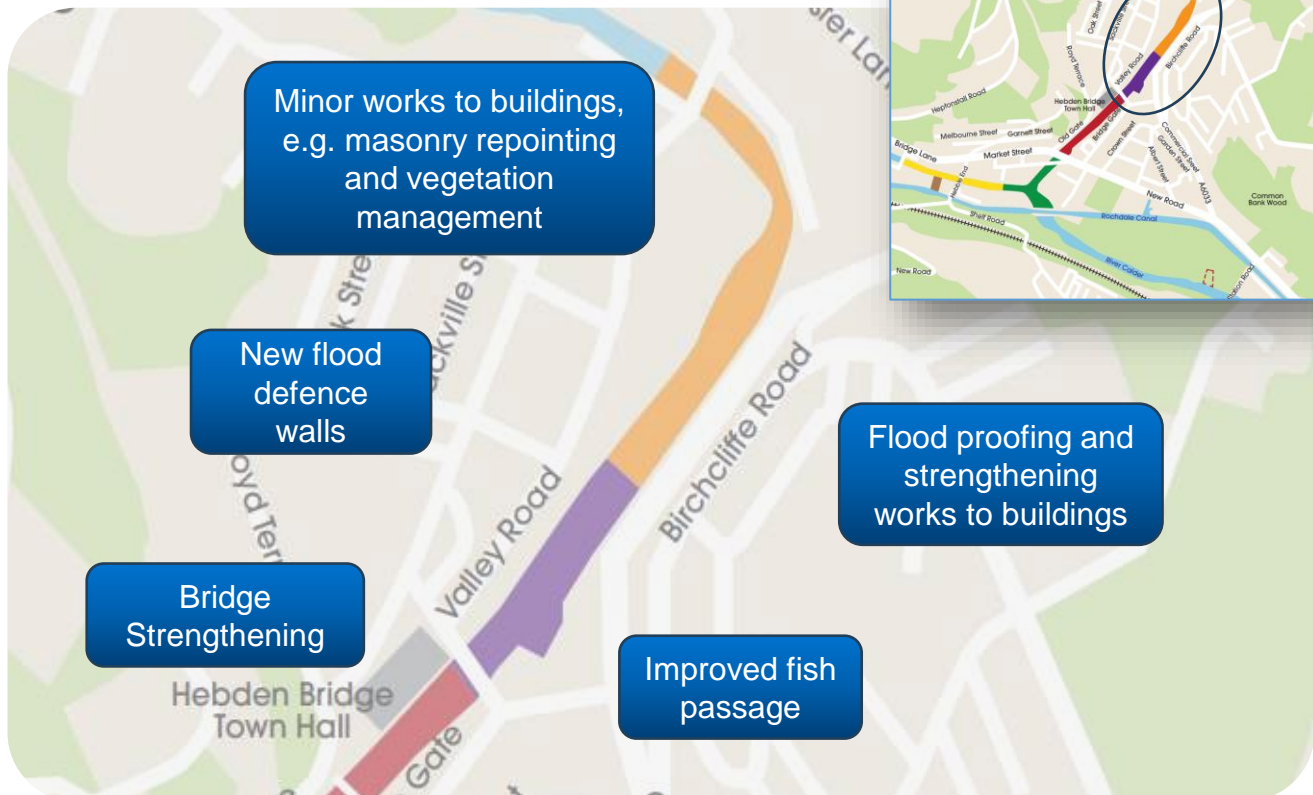

Zone D - On the right bank of Hebden Water, behind the buildings fronting Valley Road, works will include the refurbishment or partial reconstruction of existing walls. On the left bank, near the Grade II listed White Lion pub and Grade II listed Bridge Mill, a.k.a 'Innovation Mill', new flood walls will be constructed, alongside the refurbishment of existing river walls, including increases in height.

Activity in this zone will include strengthening works to the Grade II listed St George's Bridge and internal strengthening works to the aforementioned Innovation Mill. A new rock ramp or fish pass will be added to Innovation Mill weir to improve fish passage.

Zone E - In this zone, minor refurbishment works are required to the riverside wall.



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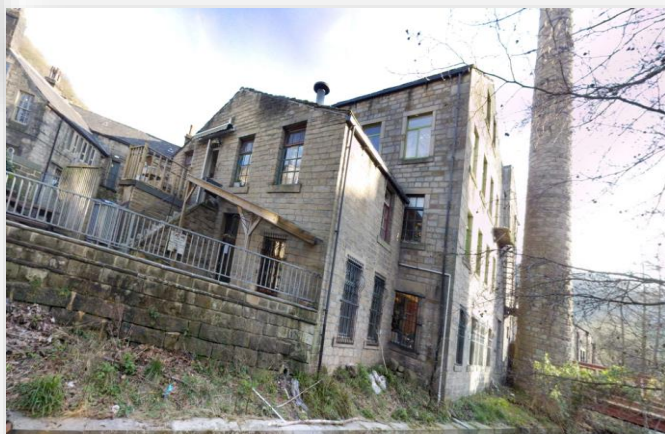
Zones D & E – Hebden Water
