Hebden Bridge Flood Alleviation Scheme

The Environment Agency is working with Calderdale Council to design and build a Flood Alleviation Scheme for Hebden Bridge.

Planning Application Submission - Live

The Planning Application for the Hebden Bridge Flood Alleviation Scheme (FAS) is now live.

A copy of the Environmental Statement and Non-Technical Summary is also available to view at Hebden Bridge Town Hall.

The scheme for Hebden Bridge will reduce the risk of flooding from Hebden Water and River Calder and includes:

- Repair and reconstruction of the river walls
- Construction of new walls within St Pols Car Park
- Construction of vertical rising flood barriers on Bridge Gate and Old Gate
- The repair and reinforcement of specific properties
- Modification to five weirs
- The replacement of Central Street Footbridge
- Reinforcement of two bridges across Hebden Water
- Landscaped public open spaces.
