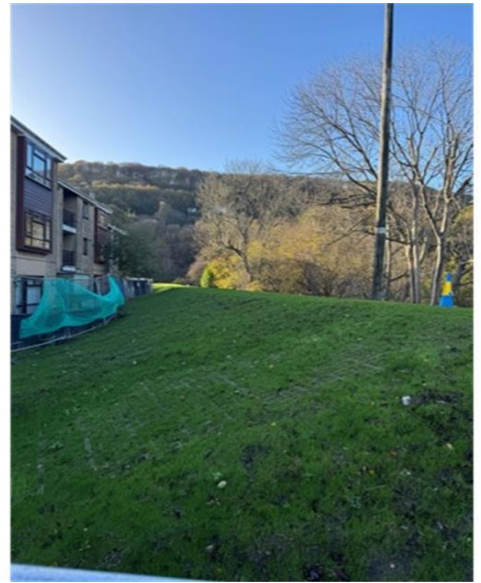
Copley Flood Alleviation Scheme

Embankment re-opening

We are pleased to inform you that following the successful completion of the Copley Flood Alleviation Scheme (FAS), we will shortly be re-opening the embankment to the public.

The re-opening had been delayed to allow the embankment to be re-seeded and for the new grass to become fully established, helping to ensure the long-term condition of the area.

Our contractor, BAM, will begin removing the Heras fencing from Thursday this week (16th July), and we expect the embankment and surrounding area to be fully re-opened by the end of next week.



We would like to take this opportunity to thank the local community for your patience, understanding and support throughout the delivery of this important project. Over the past few years, the works have been carried out to provide improved flood protection for Copley and help reduce the risk of flooding in the future.
